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The Active Travel team at Limerick City and County Council, with funding from the National Transport Authority, is tasked with expanding and upgrading Limerick's cycling and walking network.

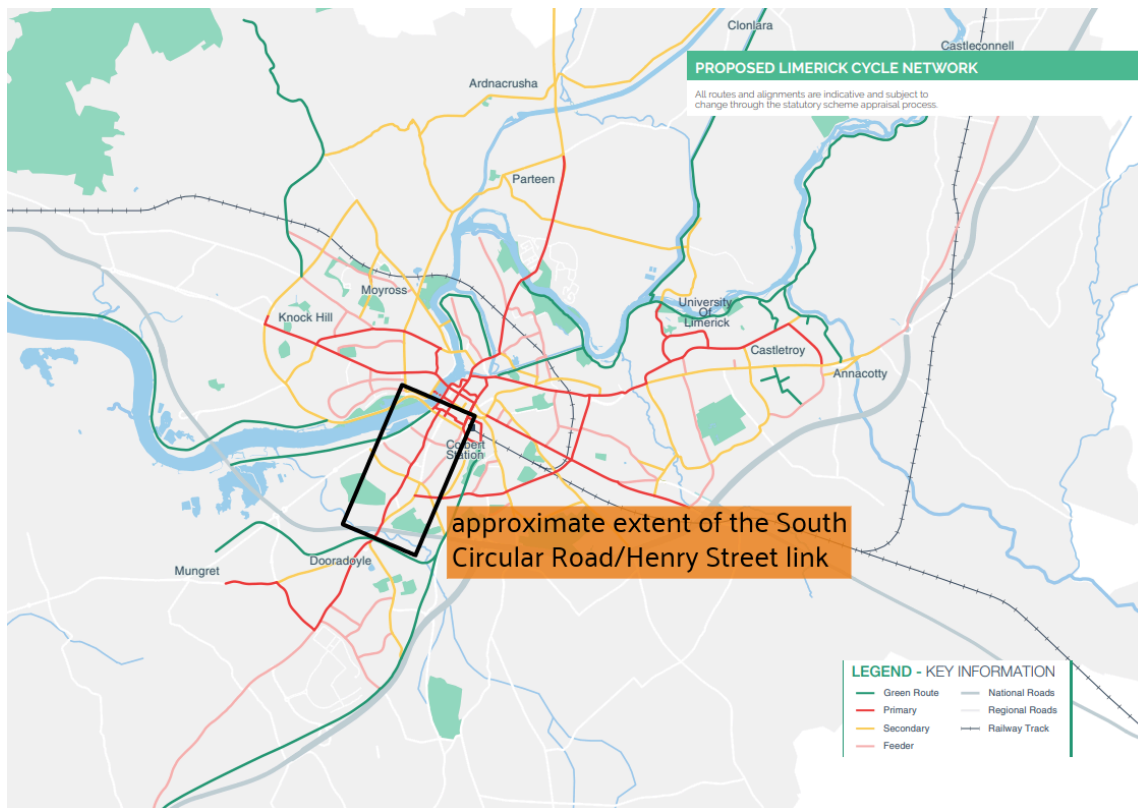
South Circular Road Active Travel Link

Construction to Commence on South Circular Road Active Travel Scheme

Construction of the South Circular Road Active Travel Scheme will commence on 20 July 2026, with Sorensen Civil Engineering appointed as the contractor to deliver the project.

Active Travel infrastructure is delivered through individual schemes that together will create a connected network. The South Circular Road Active Travel Scheme is a key link in the strategic corridor connecting the communities of Dooradoyle and Raheen with Limerick City Centre.

The scheme builds on completed active travel infrastructure on Father Russell Road, St. Nessian's Road and the R510 corridor, with another link between St. Paul's and Ballykeeffe roundabouts currently under construction. Through connections via Baggot Estate, Childers Road and Hyde Road, the wider network also provides links towards the University of Limerick, Colbert Station and other key destinations across the city.



Construction will be carried out in phases to minimise disruption where possible. Initial works will commence simultaneously at two locations: on South Circular Road between **Fennessy's and Scoil Mháthair Dé**, and on Henry Street between its **junctions with St. Alphonsus Street and O'Curry Street**.

Works are anticipated to take place **Monday to Friday between 8.00am and 8.00pm, and on Saturdays between 9.00am and 4.00pm**.

Residents, businesses and road users are encouraged to stay informed throughout construction by subscribing to the Active Travel newsletter and Sorensen's project bulletins, which will provide regular updates on progress, upcoming works and traffic management arrangements.

TUS to City Centre Active Travel project



What has been done

- Footpath and shared surface works have continued at Belfield Court, including road resurfacing.
- Preparation works started at Gaelscoil Sáirséal to facilitate a new shared surface area and improved pedestrian access for children.
- Enabling works are underway to set back sections of the existing boundary wall and create a new dedicated pedestrian entrance to the school.

What is coming

- Footpath and cycle lane construction will continue on North Sexton Street.
- Works at Gaelscoil Sairséal will progress, including the construction of the new shared surface area.
- The new school access arrangements will help connect Gaelscoil Sairséal with the wider active travel network, linking into the TUS to City Centre scheme at Hassett's Cross.

St. Paul's to Ballykeeffe Roundabout

What has been done

- Additional drainage infrastructure has been installed outside St. Paul's.
- Gas network diversion works have been completed in the area.
- New kerbing has been installed in preparation for footpath construction.
- Areas for upcoming concrete footpath pours have been prepared.

What is coming

- Drainage installation works will continue.
- The area will be backfilled following drainage works.
- Construction of new footpaths will commence.

Corbally Road SRTS

What has been done

- Footpath upgrade works between Lanahrone Avenue and Mill Road have been completed.
- Existing footpaths were removed and replaced with new kerbing and concrete surfaces.
- Foundations for the new boundary wall in Bishops Field have been completed.
- Works have progressed on the new entrance to St Munchin's College.

What is coming

- Construction of the new boundary wall in Bishops Field will continue.
- Works will continue on the foundations for the new entrance pillars at St Munchin's College.



Old Cratloe Road AT Scheme

What has been done

- Construction commenced on a new section of active travel infrastructure in front of TUS.
- New footpaths, cycle facilities and a bus stop are being delivered to link into TUS to City Centre corridor at Moylish Roundabout.

What is coming

- Construction of the new footpath and cycle facilities will continue in the area around the entrance to Caherdavin Meadows and towards Cratloe Wood Student Village.



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
