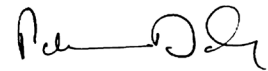


Director General Executive Report

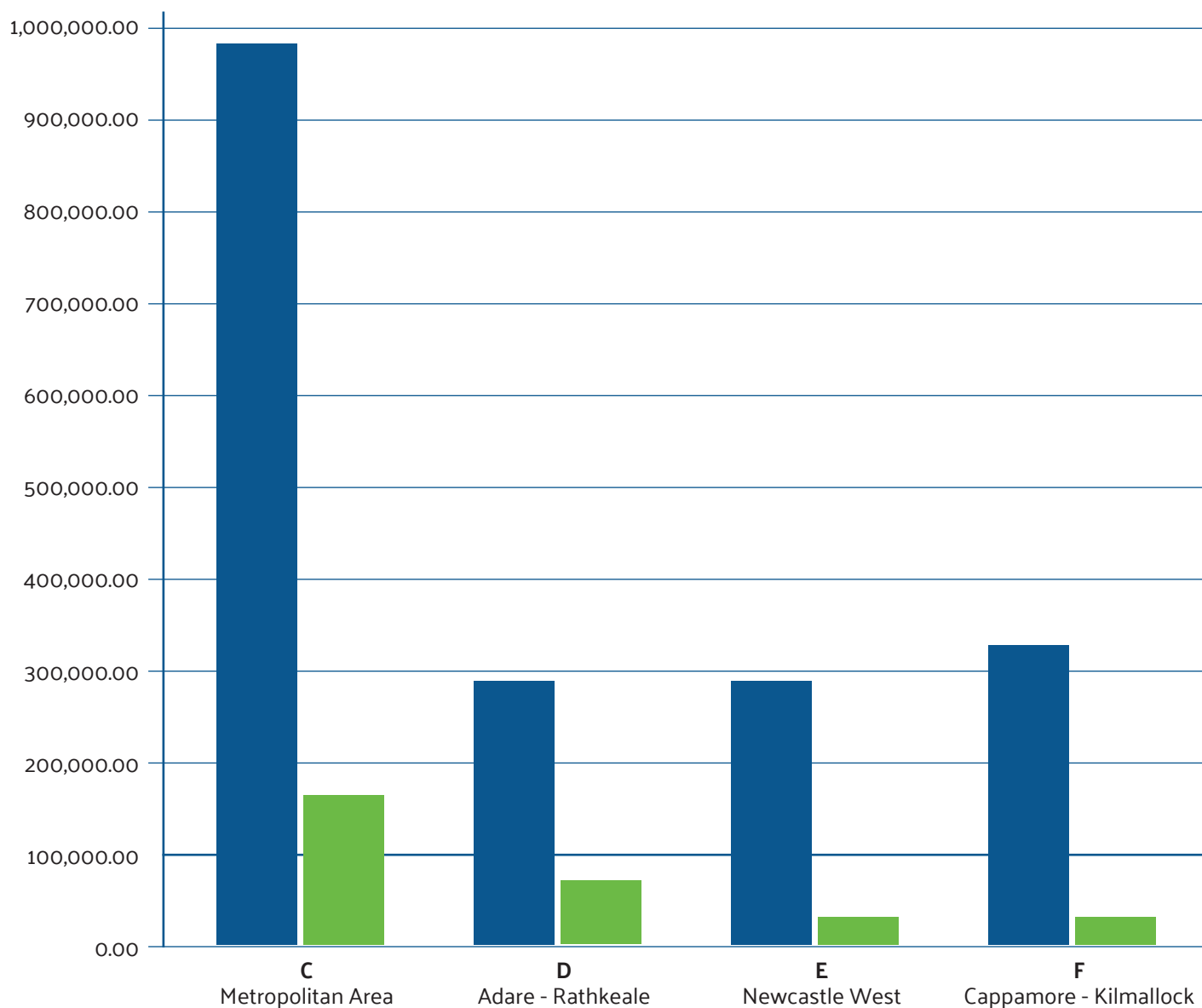


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General Municipal Allocation 2026 Adopted Estimate €1.872 Million

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2. Housing Assistance Payment Shared Services Centre (HAP SSC)

- There were 47,163 active HAP tenancies nationally, managed by the HAP SSC at the end of June.
- A weekly average of 115 HAP tenancies have been set-up during 2026.
- The June landlord payment run was €49.05 million.
- The weekly tenant charge at the end of June, was €3.2 million.
- The Debt Management Unit of the HAP SSC collected a total of €78.5 million in differential rent to end of June.
- The HAP tenant rent collection rate at the end of June was 97%.
- The Debt Management Unit issued 8,272 HAP debt reminder letters in June.

4. Digital Services and Information and Communications Technology (ICT)

Digital Services

Orders Routing and Compliance Automation (ORCA)

- The new ORCA system was launched in early June. ORCA delivers a fully digitised workflow for the generation of both Mayoral and Director General orders, with each order moving through defined governance stages and all activity at each stage captured in a detailed audit trail, culminating in the application of a legally compliant electronic signature. The system provides real-time visibility into the status of orders, allowing improved oversight and identification of delays within the process. The introduction of ORCA largely eliminates the need to print, transport, and manually track orders, memos and supporting documents, reduces rework, and improves transparency and control while reducing risk.

ICT

Datacentre Refresh / Hybrid Cloud

- Datacentre refresh progressed through active delivery phase, with vendor coordination and installation activity ongoing.
- Core infrastructure implementation continued in line with planned timelines.

Phone System / Contact Centre Upgrade

- Tender clarification process completed for Corporate Telephony and Contact Centre solution.
- Formal evaluation process commenced following receipt of submissions.

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Limerick City
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Microsoft Licensing / E5 Transition

- Enterprise Agreement renewal completed, with Microsoft 365 E5 licences provisioned in the tenant.
- Staged assignment of licences commenced across staff.
- Enhanced security, compliance, and governance capabilities being progressed.

Copilot / Artificial intelligence (AI) Governance

- Controlled Copilot rollout continued, with focus on governance, security, and cost management controls.

Cyber Security and Risk

- Cyber security monitoring and June update deployment continued across core infrastructure and user devices.
- Cyber security maturity review and Network and Information Security 2 (NIS2) alignment activities progressed.
- Cloudflare Domain Name System (DNS) migration completed with initial validation confirming service stability.

ICT Governance

- ICT policy development progressed to support security, operational consistency and audit compliance.
- Supporting procedures advanced for asset lifecycle management and media handling.
- Governance model for ICT reviewed to strengthen oversight arrangements.

2. Local Enterprise Office (LEO) Limerick

- LEO Limerick ran six Training Programmes and Business Advice Clinics for Limerick based businesses, which were attended by over 55 business owners from across the City and County.
- The LEO Limerick Evaluations Committee met on 16 June to assess grant applications from Limerick based enterprises. A total of 10 applications were approved, with a value of over €253,000 and supporting over 50 jobs locally.
- The National Enterprise Awards Final took place in the Round Room of Dublin's Mansion House on 18 June where 31 enterprises from all over Ireland were competing in the National Final. Eventmaster was the County Finalist representing Limerick on the national stage and took home the Best in Region Award (Mid-West).

Customer Services

The Customer Services Team continued to support our customers and Public Representatives at first point of contact by answering queries via telephone, email, My Limerick and social media. Case creation, payments processing and generally facilitating applications for all Limerick City and County Council services also continued throughout the month.

The following figures highlight the activity within the contact centre throughout the month:

- Customer Services Call Centre answered 9,392 calls. This represents an average of 447 per day, with the number of calls reaching as high as 549 on one particular day. 85% of calls were handled at first point of contact.
- A total of 4,529 emails were processed through our Customer Services email platform.
- 3,432 cases were created, with 869 of these logged on behalf of Public Representatives. Customer Services staff logged 72% of the cases created.
- 3,772 cases were closed, with 1,073 of these being cases logged by Public Representatives.
- The logging of cases through the My Limerick portal continued, with a total of 67 cases being logged. Of these, 55 were submitted by Public Representatives.
- 98% of Housing Maintenance cases for the Metropolitan District of Limerick were logged by Customer Services staff in the Dooradoyle and Merchants Quay offices.
- A total of 149 out-of-hours cases being created.
- 86 Residential Parking Permits were applied for and 62 issued.
- Customer Services staff welcomed a total of 3,052 customers at both our Merchants Quay and Dooradoyle offices.
