1. Welcome

The Cathaoirleach welcomed everyone to the meeting. He thanked his fellow Councillors for their work and input over the previous 12 months. The Members congratulated Cllr Conway on his year as Cathaoirleach, and they acknowledged the fair and impartial manner that he conducted meetings and discussions with the Members and staff.

2. To elect a Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock to hold office until the next Annual Meeting or until a successor has been elected.

The outgoing Cathaoirleach, Councillor Conway invited nominations for the Office of Cathaoirleach for the coming year.

Proposed by Councillor Stokes;

Seconded by Councillor M. Ryan.

"That Councillor Tommy O'Sullivan be appointed Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock, to hold office until the next Annual Meeting or until a successor has been appointed."

As there were no other nominations, the Elected Members declared Councillor O'Sullivan elected as Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock.

Cllr O'Sullivan stated that it was a huge honour for both him and his family to be elected as Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District, which is the biggest Municipal District in Limerick. He congratulated the outgoing Cathaoirleach for the way he managed Meetings and events as Cathaoirleach during his term. 3. To elect a Leas-Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock to hold office until the next Annual Meeting or until a successor has been elected.

The newly elected Cathaoirleach then invited nominations for the office of Leas-Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock for the forthcoming year.

Proposed by Councillor Conway;
Seconded by Councillor M. Ryan.

"That Councillor Noreen Stokes be appointed Leas-Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock to hold office until the next Annual Meeting or until a successor has been appointed."

As there were no other nominations, the Cathaoirleach declared Councillor Stokes elected as Leas-Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of Cappamore-Kilmallock and wished her well for the forthcoming year.

The Members congratulated the newly elected Cathaoirleach and Leas Cathaoirleach on their election and wished them well for the twelve months ahead. They agreed on the importance of all working constructively together in the Municipal District.

The A/Senior Engineer, on behalf of management and staff, congratulated the Cathaoirleach and Leas Cathaoirleach on their election and wished them well for the year ahead. This concluded the Meeting.
