

Active Travel Scheme Old Cratloe Road



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Over the past number of weeks, significant progress has been made on the Old Cratloe Road improvement works. The road crossing at Whitehorn Drive has now been completed.

Existing footpaths have been excavated across from the entrance to Caherdavin Meadows down to the pedestrian crossing at Red Gate Road. New concrete footpaths have been installed along the first section and a base layer of asphalt has been installed in the second section. The third section will be completed next week, with a final layer of tar poured in the coming weeks.

Works on the crossing point at the brow of the hill are completed on one side of the road.

At the western end of the road, between the roundabout and Shannonvale, the existing footpath has been excavated and replaced with new footpaths. In addition, a new road crossing has been constructed at the entrance to Shannonvale.

Next week, the contractor will continue drainage improvement works and the realignment of road gullies along the route. The temporary traffic management that is running from Caherdavin Meadows to Redgate road will be in place for another week.



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
