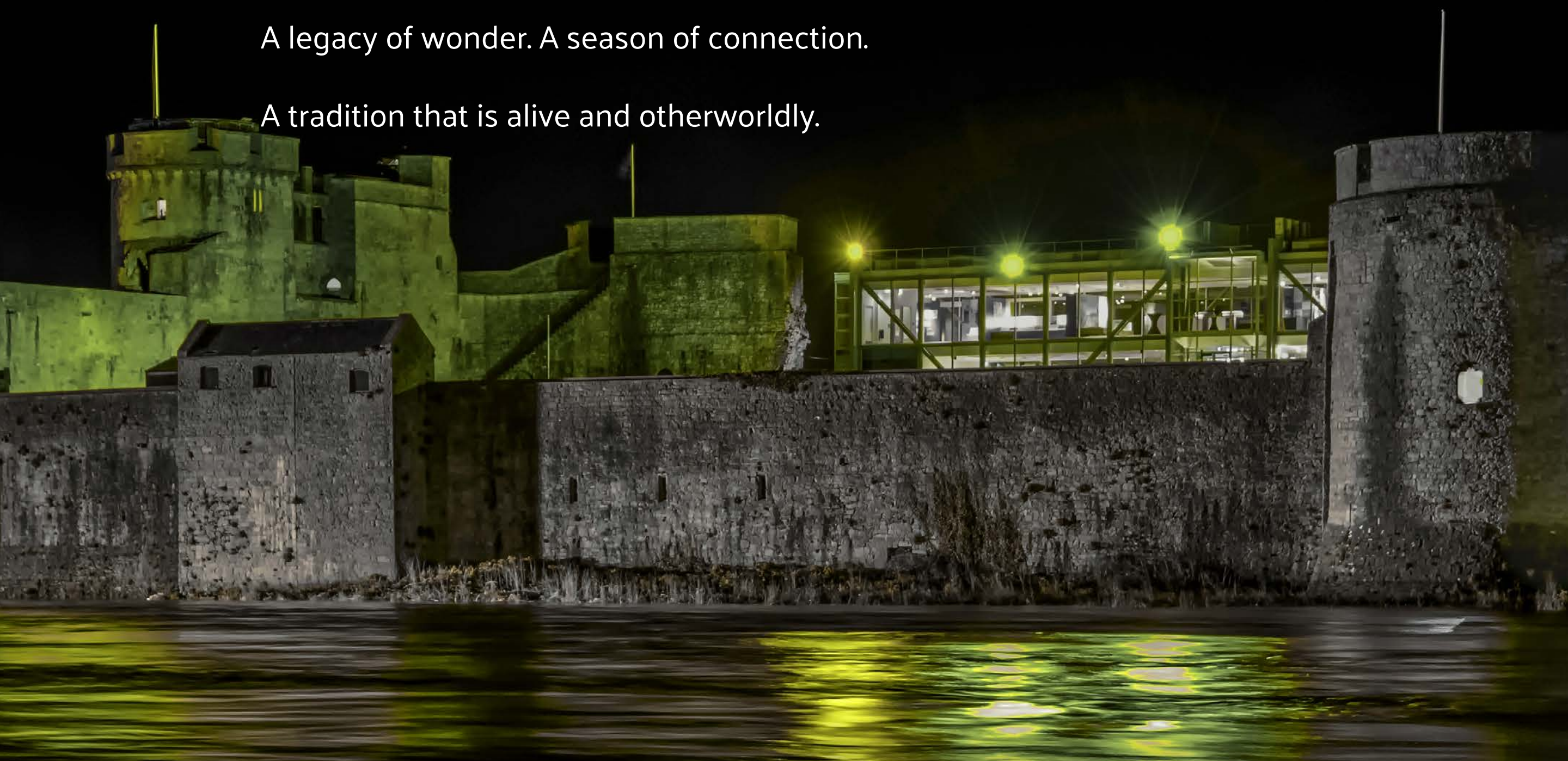
Visitors can wander misty forests and haunted castles. Taste the season, and celebrate in a way that's deeply rooted and utterly alive.

MYSTERY SAMHAIN BANQUET

Upon arrival, guests will enter a transformed historic space featuring long banquet tables, atmospheric lighting, immersive set design and live performances inspired by Irish mythology and local folklore. The experience will include a three-course seasonal menu celebrating traditional Samhain foods and locally sourced ingredients, complemented by storytelling, music and theatrical performances.
