

Active Travel Scheme Old Cratloe Road



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Over the past week, plastering works were completed on the first section of the new boundary wall at Caherdavin Meadows.

Works also progressed on the new pedestrian crossing adjacent to Caherdavin Meadows, with construction continuing on the opposite side of the road, working down towards the bus stop.

A new crossing was installed at the junction into Galtee Avenue.

Next week, works will continue on the pedestrian crossing near Caherdavin Meadows. Existing footpaths will be excavated and reconstructed in the direction of the bus stop.

Construction will also commence on the new crossing point at the entrance to Cratloe Student Village in the week commencing 14 September. In the meantime, existing footpaths will be realigned to accommodate the new pedestrian crossing.

To facilitate these works, 24-hour traffic management will be in place throughout the week.
