

# Active Travel Scheme Ballykeefe



## Weekly Bulletin

*4th September 2026*

This past week, works have continued on the installation of new kerbing and footpath areas outside St. Paul's Nursing Home, with steady progress being made along this section of the scheme.

Drainage works have also continued at the entrance to Ballykeefe Estate. To facilitate these essential works, the bus corridor along Ballykeefe Road has remained out of service this week and will continue to be unavailable next week.

A new work area has been established outside St. Paul's Church, where excavation works have commenced in preparation for the installation of new service ducting.

Next week, drainage works will continue at the entrance to Ballykeefe Estate. At the Ballykeefe Roundabout, a landscaping team will be on site on Wednesday to undertake vegetation clearance and site preparation works in advance of the next phase of construction. Kerbing and footpath construction will continue outside St. Paul's Nursing Home, while works outside St. Paul's Church will progress with the installation of new service ducting following the completion of excavation activities.
